

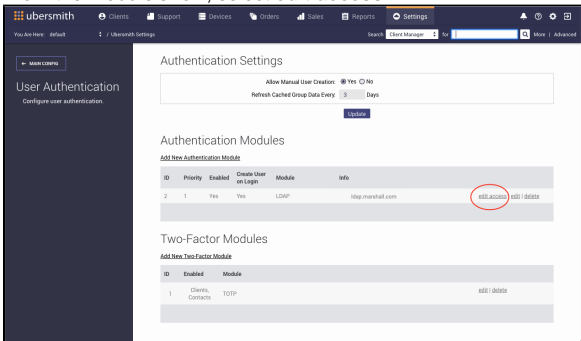
# Managing Authentication Modules

Once you have [created an authentication module](#), you can perform various actions on it.

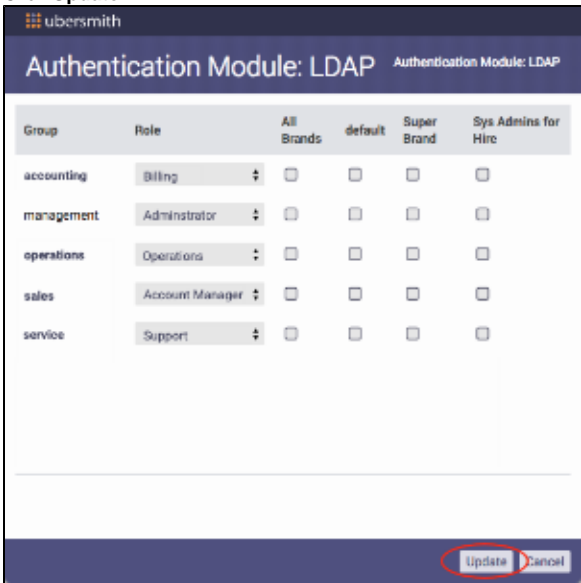
## Editing Access for Authentication Modules

You can match authentication groups from your authentication server to your defined Ubersmith roles, so the user rights will carry from the group to the role.

1. [Access the User Authentication page](#).
2. From the module's row, select **edit access**.



- The *Authentication Module* page appears.
3. In each group's row, select the corresponding Ubersmith role that you want to assign to the group.
  4. In each group's row, select one or more brands you want to assign to the group.
  5. Click **Update**.

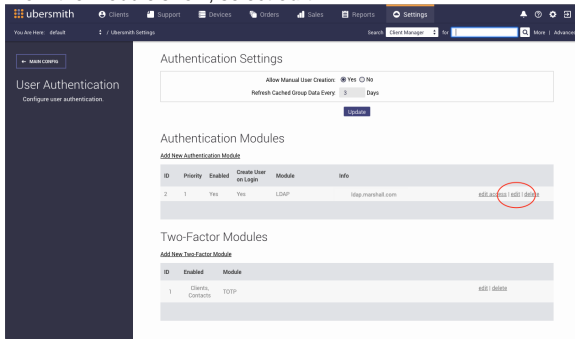

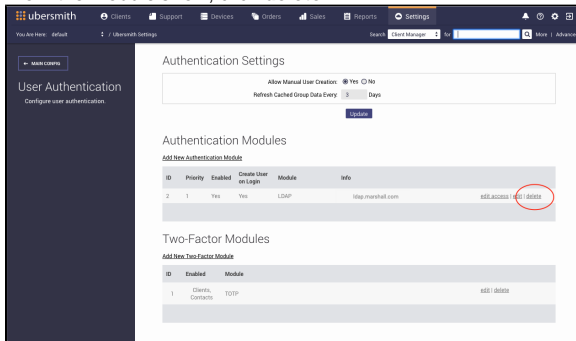
The *Edit Authentication Module* page appears.
