


# Configuring Currency and Measurements

You can configure your local currency and measurement unit system on this page.


## Access the Currency & Measurements Page




## Complete the Measurement Unit System Section

- For your local paper size, select either **Letter** or **A4**.




## Complete the Currency Section

5. Click **Save** or **Save & New**.








3. Make any necessary changes.

## Deleting Currency


1. Access the *Currency & Measurements* page.


